## 14 Alcoholic Home

### World - Problem

Apart from some Middle East countries where use of alcohol is almost non-existent, alcohol is a worldwide problem

### Why do People Drink?

- To fit in and be sociable
- Makes them feel good & look for this sensation more and more
- Generational line
- Numb inner pain
- Trying to hide
- Suffered a loss – loved one, job, business, health
- Elderly people – feel redundant, bored or fearful about future

### Addictions

- Gradual process
- First time best high – never have again

### Definition of Addiction

It is where someone has chosen to make a habit of repeatedly allowing a substance or behaviour to control them and thereby becoming addicted to it.

### **Romans 6:16 (AMP)**

**Do you not know that if you continually surrender is yourselves to anyone to do his will, you are his slaves of him whom you obey, whether that be to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience which leads to righteousness (right doing and right standing with God)?**

### The Alcoholic Family

- Never know what to expect when you arrive home
- They try and hide it from everyone
- Cover up for the alcoholic person, make excuses
- Family live in denial

# Jesus, My Life

## Foundations

### The Roles that are Taken on in an Alcoholic Home

- Stress on the family is huge
- Present a front to the world – “Normal” family
- Not aware of the fact reverted to survival roles
- Financial strain
- Spouse takes on duties of the alcoholic
- One of children, usually eldest runs the home and looking after younger siblings
- Robbed of the normal carefree childhood
- Use humour to deflect painful and embarrassing situations
- A child can become “invisible”
- Peacemaker – constantly tries to reduce the constant conflict
- Children excel at school, studies, sport or work to prove family is normal and healthy

### Facing Reality

- Family can play major role in lovingly helping the alcoholic
- They are often lulled into accepting the situation
- False sense of loyalty to protect the alcoholic’s reputation
- Roles taken on as children to cope extend into adult lives without them being aware of it

### Helping the Alcoholic

- The family needs to repent of unwittingly aiding and abetting the alcoholic
- They need to forgive the alcoholic of emotional, mental or physical pain as well as any shame, humiliation and embarrassment due to the alcoholic’s out of control actions
- Forgive their selfish and self-centred spending at the expense of the family
- Bind down spirits of addiction, deception, abuse, anger, fear, low self-image, low self-worth, self-centredness, selfishness, unlovable spirit, spirit of rejection, self-rejection and fear of rejection.
- Pray in the Lord’s truth and love, His comfort and that alcoholic’s spiritual eyes and ears to be opened - expose the root cause of the need to drink.

# Jesus, My Life

## Foundations

### Praying for Adult's from an Alcoholic Home

- Need to forgive the alcoholic
- Cut all ungodly soul ties, cut them off from generational spirits of alcohol and addiction
- See of took on any coping or survival roles
- Ask the Lord to break all wrong beliefs, attitudes, habits, addictions (false comforts), bitter root expectation
- Ask the Lord to heal all painful traumatic memories
- Pray for release and healing to grow emotionally where have been frozen into this time of trauma
- Ask the Lord to restore their lost childhood, joy and spontaneity
- Also that Lord will bring the love, comfort and nurture needed to heal their broken heart
- **Isaiah 61**
  - He came to set captives free
  - Comfort for broken-hearted
  - Gives beauty for ashes, oil of joy for mourning
  - Praise for despair
  - Inherit a double portion of prosperity and everlasting joy instead of shame
  - He rewards His people for his suffering
  - We are clothed with His robe of righteousness, like a garden in the Spring, fill with young plants, springing up everywhere.

### Conclusion

Christ came to set the captive free. Freedom is His salvation message. Anyone who believes can receive their healing, deliverance and salvation from Christ.

### 16 Dealing with Anger

Ephesians 4:26,27 (AMP)

When angry, do not sin; do not ever let your wrath (your exasperation, your fury or indignation) last until the sun goes down. Leave no (such) room or foothold for the devil (give no opportunity to him).

Gal. 5: 19 - 21 (NKJV)

Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries and the like. Those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Gal 5:24 (ESV)

Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

Anger is caused by something or someone that is preventing us from obtaining a goal that we feel is very important to us or else we find ourselves responding to a situation that is highly aggravating to us.

#### Are you angry?

- What is making me feel angry?
- Why am I feeling anger and not some other emotion?
- Am I jumping to conclusions about the situation or person that threatens me and makes me feel afraid or inferior?
- Did my anger come because I had some unrealistic expectation?
- How might others, including the person who is angering me, view this situation?
- Is there any other way to look at the situation?
- Are there things I can do to change the situation in order to reduce my anger?
- Do I find it hard to forgive someone who has angered me?
- Am I able to eventually forgive, but I cannot let go?
- When someone confronts me, am I thinking how I can defend myself or genuinely wanting to correct the situation?
- Do I avoid confrontation?
- Do I withdraw easily?
- Do I avoid people that dislike me?
- Do I feel on the edge most of the time?
- Do I have a deep desire to win irrespective of whether I am right or wrong?

- Do I slam doors, throw things, shout at people and use bad language when I am upset?

### Prayer

Father in the Name of Jesus, I thank You for being able to come before You now in order for me to deal with my anger.

I come and confess to You that I have expressed anger in an ungodly way. That there were times when I have allowed it to progress to beyond anger by dwelling on the disagreement and allowing my anger to fester and so over reacting. I ask You to please forgive me for this and also for the hurt that I have caused to the people around me.

Father where possible, help me to make amends for this.

Forgive me too Father for making excuses for my anger and not taking responsibility for it. I repent of this now.

I have also at times resorted to using anger against others by using manipulation, sulking or giving them the silent treatment. Snubbing them, using sarcasm, being critical or punishing them in subtle ways.

I see Father that this is not how You would want me to act and therefore when I experience blocked goals or can't seem to get my own way, I will no longer choose to use these immature ways of dealing with my anger and frustrations.

There have been times too Father when I was upset that I resorted to slamming doors, throwing things, shouting at people and using bad language. I also repent of this and choose to rather express my anger in a non-aggressive way and to stop resorting to this destructive way of dealing with my displeasure.

I therefore choose to surrender my anger and soulish coping mechanisms to You in this regard.

Help me in to grow in this area and to learn how to communicate in a calm way and to be able to see the other person's point of view and to remember to include You, Lord in this area of my life from now on.

### 17 Strife

The definition of the word “Strife”

Strife:

Words associated with it:

Trouble, conflict, discord, contention, fighting, dissention, friction, rivalry, disharmony, heated disagreement, and an angry undercurrent.

What does the Bible have to say about strife?

Prov 17:1

Better is a dry morsel with quietness than a house full of feasting with strife.

Prov 17:14

The beginning of strife is as when water first trickles (from a crack in a dam); therefore stop contention before it becomes worse and quarrelling breaks out.

#### A person causing strife.

Has a negative attitude due to a wound in the soul (mind and/or emotions).

Why?

- Grew up in home with strife.
- Experienced feelings of shame and rejection.
- Exposed to lack of nurturing and harsh, unloving, unkind environment.
- Grew up in home that does not allow mistakes, failure is not acceptable.
- Often feeling out of control.
- Adopted children.

#### Strongholds

Offense: taking and giving offense.

Rejection: wanting to be loved & accepted for who they are.

Judgement & Criticism of works.

Person causing strife is usually selfish and thinks that everyone else has a problem but there is nothing wrong with them.



# Jesus, My Life

## Foundations

### A person receiving strife.

Has a fearful attitude due to unpredictable behaviour from person causing strife

### Why?

- Seeks love and recognition from person causing strife.
- Unable to predict emotional outbursts, living on egg shells.
- Unable to resolve conflict .
- Constantly being broken down when trying to succeed and/or achieve.
- Does not value self as a person worthy of respect.

### Strongholds

- Rejection: wanting to be loved & accepted for who they are.
- Bitterness: nothing I ever do is good enough.
- Unforgiveness: forming a hatred towards the person causing strife.

A person living with strife needs to learn to set clear boundaries and be careful not to become a person causing strife later on in life.

### Keep strife out of your life!

James 3:13-18(NIV)

Don't harbour bitter envy, selfish ambition(strife) in your hearts. This is earthly, unspiritual, of the devil.  
Be a peace maker, sow in peace and raise a harvest of righteousness

### Prayer

I also choose to forgive all of those who caused all of this in my life. I ask You Father , to heal all the emotional and mental hurt and pain that I was subjected to because of this. I also give you all the mental and emotional anguish that I have suffered and I ask Father for you to heal me in my thinking and to take all the inner turmoil that I have felt due to me trying to perform to earn approval. I also speak to all deception, lies and any unlovable spirits and I command you to leave and go to the place that Jesus commands you to.

I ask You, Father to break and revoke all curses and any other assignments that are attached to all of this strife and cruelty. I ask You, Father to forgive me where I have been the one to cause strife and pain in the lives of others. Forgive me where I have spoken unkindly and harshly to anyone and put them down so that I could save face and not be seen in a negative light; where this was done out of performance and fear and selfish motives, causing them to feel unloved and unaccepted.

Forgive me for my critical, judgmental and unkind attitude towards them. I thank You that You have good pre-planned paths and works set out especially for me to do. I ask You to direct me to these paths and good works. I also pray protection on all the plans that You have for me and to seal in all that has been done here today.

- Identify if it is satan and his evil devils

### Do my thoughts impact my health?

Thoughts that are not rejected form a tree shaped structure in your brain:

- As you meditate on this thought it strengthens it, the branches increase and thicken.
- Chemicals/hormones are released into the body as a result of this.
- Good – balanced/good for you but bad – unbalance, toxic chemicals
- Emotions are also attached to these chemicals/hormones.
- 2 Cor10:5 - **lead away(put off), take captive every thought.**
- Every time we go back to memory it adds branches
- Good news – when we chose to reject bad and replace it with good – it changes the structure of the “tree” in your mind = renewing.
- Dr Michelle Strydom – 21 days to completely give your tree a makeover.

## Prayer

Father , I come to you and confess that I have realized that I have allowed the actions, words and behaviour of significant people in my life to influence me and my view of myself in a negative way.

I confess that I have allowed these negative attitudes that have come from them to distort my inner picture of myself. I confess that without realizing it, I have internalized these negative behaviour patterns and believed them to be true.

I confess that I have taken their attitude of me over and above what You and Your Word has to say about me.

I confess that I have been negative and critical in my thinking not only of myself but of You and others as well.

I ask You to please forgive me for this and I renounce these negative actions and words that have come down onto me and ask You to please break the impact that they have had on my life.

I pray for a crop failure over all of these negative words that have been spoken over me and I ask you to revoke all curses that have been attached to them. I ask You to forgive me for bowing to the demonic spirits that are behind all of this namely:- unlovable spirit, rejection, self-rejection, fear of rejection, inferiority, insecurity, low self-esteem. Fear, fear of failure, fear of man, criticism and fear of criticism. Hatred and self-hatred, self-bitterness, guilt, shame, resentment and unforgiveness.

I take away the rights and authority that you have had in my life and I chose in the Name of Jesus to close these doors off over you and I tell you to leave on the breath now and go to the place Jesus' assigns you to.

I ask You to please forgive me for using ungodly methods of striving to gain love and approval. I repent of this and ask You to help me to not try to manipulate people to love and accept me. Father , I ask you to forgive me for rejecting myself and so cursing myself.

I ask you to revoke these curses off of me in the Name of Jesus. I choose now to accept myself just as I am, asking You to continue to mould and make me into the Blue Print that You have for my life.

I ask You to come and heal all the emotional pain that I have felt due to entertaining and believing the lies that I have come under. I pray for Your love and comfort to fill these empty, hurting places in me.

### 19 Fear

#### The Origin of Fear

Gen 3:9, 10 (NIV)

But the Lord God called to the man, “Where are you?” He answered, “I heard you in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid.”

#### Normal Godly Fear

Fear is an unpleasant emotion caused by exposure to danger, which can be seen, heard or felt.

So fear in itself is not wrong, as it is there to warn us so that we do not get injured in some way and can therefore do something about our situation.

- For someone to feel fear sub-consciously, the object that is causing them to fear will in their minds possess the power to be able to harm them and so they feel that it is more powerful than they are.
- Fear causes us to become alert and ready to defend ourselves or to be able to make a hasty retreat i.e. “fight or flight.”

#### Ungodly Fear

Ungodly fear is when we find ourselves in the “fight and flight” mode and we are not even sure why we feel that way. The reason being is that it is all buried in our sub-conscience minds/spirits and we are being controlled by an unseen belief system that has been based on fear, which could well be associated with a crisis/trauma. This can also be coupled with sadness and anger.

So the object of their fear is not actually real but is actually all in their minds/spirits but to the person it is as real as if it were happening to them then and there.

Isa 26:3-4 (AMP)

“You will guard him and keep him in perfect peace and constant peace, whose mind (both its inclination and character) is stayed on you, because he commits himself to You, leans on You and hopes confidently in You.”

V4 So trust in the Lord, commit yourself to Him lean on Him, hope confidently in Him forever; for the Lord God is an everlasting Rock (the Rock of Ages).”

Isa 25:1(AMP)

O Lord, You are my God, I will exalt You, I will praise Your name, for You have done marvellous things, even purposes planned of old (and fulfilled) in faithfulness and truth.

2 Chron 20:1–22 AMP)

A vast army were coming against the Israelites. Jehoshaphat feared, but set himself (determinedly, as his vital need) to seek the Lord. . . He needed a battle plan and only one from the Lord would work.

- They spent time waiting for God’s heart about their problem. In verse 15 the Lord’s reply is: “Be not afraid nor dismayed at this great multitude for the battle is not yours, but God’s”.
- Verse 20 Jehoshaphat’s directive to them is, “Believe in the Lord your God and you shall be established.”
- They appointed singers to praise the Lord, and the Lord set ambushes against their enemies and they were saved.

Psalms 23:4

Yes, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will not fear or dread no evil for You are with me; Your rod to correct and Your staff to guide and comfort me.”

- This is a place of trauma that the Psalmist is talking about here but he says that we can know the Lord’s comfort and we do not need to fear or dread any evil because He is with us. We will know His presence and the ability to walk through this place as we allow Him to correct and guide us.

### Divine Exchange

So as we come before the Lord, we can ask Him to help us to exchange our strongholds of doubt and brokenness for His life and healing and the opposite of what we are experiencing. We do not have to be bound by anything.

- Fear is not content to remain static in our lives, it wants to take over but we can decide, once we have seen that it is operating in us, that we are not going to bow to it any longer.
- We will always know fear as it's an emotion but we can stand in our right and authority and who we are in Christ and slowly but surely start taking back the ground that the enemy has had over our lives in the area of fear.
- Don't settle for the bondage fear, you can walk in freedom in Christ.
